



Mr. Albert "Pat" Hoffman

October 21, 1937 - February 27, 2015

Albert "Pat" J. Hoffman, age 77 years, of South Cairo, NY, passed away on Friday, February 27, 2015 at Kingston City Hospital.

He was born on October 21, 1937, in Mineola, LI NY, and was the son of Albert and Louise (Goldbach)Hoffman.

Pat proudly served in The United States Air Force from 1956-1964 as a Nuclear Load Master. He was employed by and retired from New York Power Pool (NYPP) now known as New York Independent System Operator (NYISO) being one of the original NYPP employees. His hobbies included reading, writing, wood carving, hunting, history, geography space exploration. He was the author of the novel Fury of the Fifth Angel. Pat was inspired by learning and was widely known as an extreme intellectual man, always eager to listen and learn from others.

Survivors include his wife of 58 magical years Arlene Hoffman who is his inspiration for everything he has ever done, his son Chris Hoffman and his wife Kim and their children Kaleigh, Jason, Kendra and Jacob. As well as being survived by his daughter Lisa Hoffman.

Memorial service will be held on Saturday, March 7, 2015 at The South Cairo United Methodist Church, at 11:00 AM with Rev. Retta Lykens, Pastor officiating.
