

## Donald Clarence "Double D" Daley

January 17, 1946 - January 6, 2021

Donald Clarence "Double D" Daley, age 74, of Coxsackie, NY, passed away on January 6th. 2021 surrounded by his loving family.

Donnie was born on January 17th, 1946 in Troy, NY to parents John W. and Amelia P. (Beaulieu) Daley.

In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by his siblings: Mary Ellen (Frederick) Berhaupt, Patricia A. (John Chico) Cecchetto, John E. (Ann) Daley Sr., and Helen E. (Donald) Gagen. Also predeceased by his infant daughter Heather Daley and nephew Gary Luby.

Throughout his lifetime he worked at: Skolite (Troy), Portec (Troy), Tex Hughes (Watervliet), Parkside Lodge (Albany), Phillips Mahnavox (Saugerties), and Kosco Oil (Kingston) from which he retired in 2010.

Donnie was a fiercely loyal and protective husband, father, brother, son, uncle, and friend. He never took the easy way out or did anything halfway. He walked many paths throughout his life, some straight and some not so straight, which gave him the gift of being a great teacher to all who crossed his path because his lessons were always sincere, honest, and from his heart.
