Paul R. Wais, Jr. age 54 years, lifetime area resident of Athens, N.Y. passed away at his home surrounded by his beloved family on February 13, 2018.

Paul was born on June 21, 1963, and is the son of Anne E. Wais of Athens, N.Y. and the late Paul R. Wais, Sr.

During his lifetime, Paul was an accomplished musician as a guitarist and lead singer for over twenty five years playing in several different bands. For his entire life, Paul was a dairy farmer, his being one of the last existing dairy farms in Athens, N.Y. Paul was a graduate of The Coxsackie-Athens Central School, Class of 1981, a member of The Zion Lutheran Church in Athens, a former member of The Coxsackie Athens Little League serving as Board Member and coach for many years, and a member for many years as Vice President for The Greene County Farm Bureau until his death, and formerly was on the Athens Zoning Board of Appeals.

Paul was a kind friend to all he met, it did not matter how long that he may have known you.

Besides his Mother Anne E. Wais of Athens, survivors include his wife of 27 years, Jane(Gilmore)Wais, daughter Julia Wais, son, Paul V. Wais, son Michael Wais and son James Wais, sisters Patricia Green (Ralph), Pamela Ericson (Emil), Wendy Wais (Mark), Jill Wais (Paul) and Betty Zaroba (Paul), and his brother John Wais (Jean).
