Ann was born in Athens, NY on July 24 th 1930, the daughter of Alfred Kniffen and Mildred (nee Scott) Kniffen. She married Gene H. Kelly on Oct 16 th 1949, in St. Mary's Catholic Church in Coxsackie, NY. They had four children together and celebrated their 69 th wedding anniversary in 2018 two months before her husband passed away.
