Arnold Edward Bowers, "The Uncle", 84, of South Cairo, NY, passed away peacefully at home on November 26, 2020. Arnold spent most of his life in Patchogue, NY, but moved to South Cairo in 2010 to be closer to his family after his beloved wife of 36 years, Mary Ellen passed away.
