Arthur James Price, age 84, of Clermont, NY passed away peacefully on September 23, 2017 at Albany Medical Center, Albany, NY.

He was born on February 10, 1933 in Hackensack, NJ to the late Herbert and Margret (Ward) Price.

Arthur's military career included serving in the United States Marine Corp. than transferring to the U.S Army Air Corp. which ultimately transitioned into the United States Air Force. He served from April 19, 1950 – October 28, 1953 in Korea as a medic with the 325th Medical Core Unit during the Korean War.
