August Jeffery "Jeff" Pohler, age 62 years, lifetime area resident of Cairo, New York, passed away on Sunday, July 7, 2019, at Columbia Memorial Hospital, Hudson, New York.

"Jeff" was born on August 30, 1956, in Catskill, New York. His Father was Gus and his Mother was Linda.

Besides his parents, he is predeceased by his sister Steponie.

Survivors include his brother Steve Pohler of Florida, and many friends and neighbors in the town of Cairo, New York, which he loved.

During his lifetime, Jeff was a mason, handy man, and a carpenter. He helped to build the buildings at The Friar Tuck Inn, In Palenville, New York. He loved to hike in The Catskill Mountains of Greene County, New York and to stroll down Main Street, Cairo, accompanied by his waling stick which attributed him with the name of "Rip Van Winkle" conversing with friends. He also has been seen enjoying riding his three-wheel bicycle that he purchased from his friend at Fallon's Hardware Store, in Cairo, New York.

Jeff proudly served in The United States Navy beginning in 1970.

Memorial services will be held at Richards Funeral Home, 29 Bross Street, Cairo, New York, on Saturday, August 31, 2019, from 10:00 A.M. – 12:00 Noon.

Funeral services will be held at 12:00 Noon, the same day, with Pastor Rick Snowden of The Community Life Church in Catskill, New York, officiating. The United States Navy Honor Guard will also conduct services the same day.

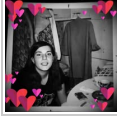

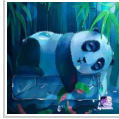
