Daniel H. Stacey, loving father and grandfather, age 89 years, lifetime area resident of Athens, N.Y., passed away on February 28, 2023, at his home in Athens, N.Y.

He was born on March 19, 1933, in Athens, N.Y. and is the son of the late William and Nora (Haynor) Stacey.

Besides his parents, he is predeceased by his loving wife Lenora “Ann” Stacey who predeceased him on July 21, 2017, and also his brother William Stacey.

Survivors include his three sons Steve and his wife Kathy, Brian and his wife Carol and Gary Stacey, five grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews and also many friends from the local area.

During Daniel’s lifetime, he served his country proudly in The United States Army during The Korean War. Employee Federal Credit Union.

Daniel had many hobbies that he enjoyed such as hunting, carpentry, working around the house, and he loved going to The Athens Senior Center where he enjoyed meals with friends. Dan enjoyed taking daily drives downtown to the river, and also visiting his wife's resting place at Mt. Hope Cemetery.
