Deborah J Riley of Valatie NY passed away at her home on November 27, 2020. Debbie graduated from Ravena Coeymans High School in June of 1970 and went on to study history and Spanish at Hartwick College subsequently earning her BA from SUNY Albany.

Debbie worked in the insurance industry for most of her career first at Kemper Insurance and then with Aetna Insurance from where she retired in 2017.

During her working years Debbie made many connections and lifelong friends of her co-workers.
