



Mrs. Eve M. Lampman

March 28, 1928 - June 9, 2020

Mrs. Eve M. Lampman, longtime resident of Catskill, N.Y., age 92 years, passed away peacefully on June 9, 2020.

She was born on March 28, 1928, in Hungary, and is the daughter of the late Paul and Helen Vezensenyi.

Besides her parents, Eve is predeceased by her loving husband Stanley who predeceased her on March 22, 1989. Stanley was a long time employee with The Town of Catskill Highway Department.

Survivors include her two sons Peter Lampman (Cathy) and Paul Lampman (Melana), her sister Betty Hirst, grandchildren Alison Ernst (Ron) and Makenzie Piwowarski, great grandchildren Ron Jr., Zachary, Alicia Aiden Ernst and Carter Piwowarski.

Eve's family left Hungary in 1945, on Eve's birthday, in railroad cattle cars. It took the family one and a half months to get to Germany as the tracks were bombed. They lived in Munich, Germany, and Eve worked for the U.S. Army motor pool. She left Germany on a Navy troop carrier in December 1949. The family arrived in Brooklyn, N.Y., from there the family moved to Cobleskill, N.Y. Eve was employed for a while at an appliance store as secretary. Later Eve was employed at The Rip Van Winkle Restaurant, where she met her beloved Stanley. Eve and her family are World War II Survivors.

During Eve's lifetime, she was a dental hygienist for over 25 years for Dr. Englert in Catskill, N.Y. and after that for a dental office in Coxsackie, N.Y. for over 20 years.
