In her last weeks of life she listened to her favorite songs in the hospital with her family by her side and dictated some of her famous recipes to her granddaughter Grace to ensure they lived on, while Nicole made sure her hair looked beautiful. She loved to garden and could be found putting around the property (her own words) planting various flowers with her grandchildren and her beloved cockapoo Red. 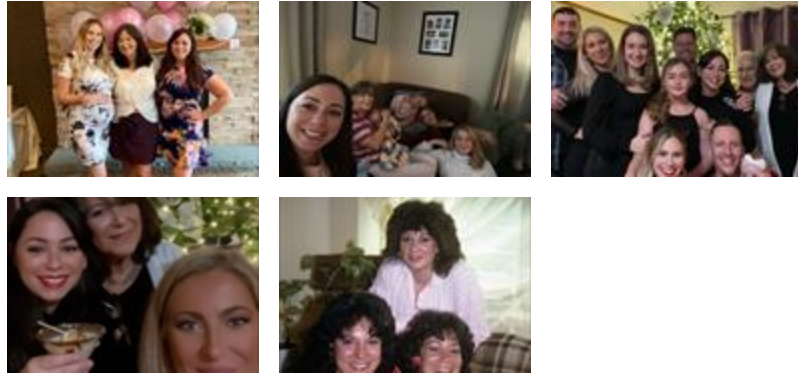

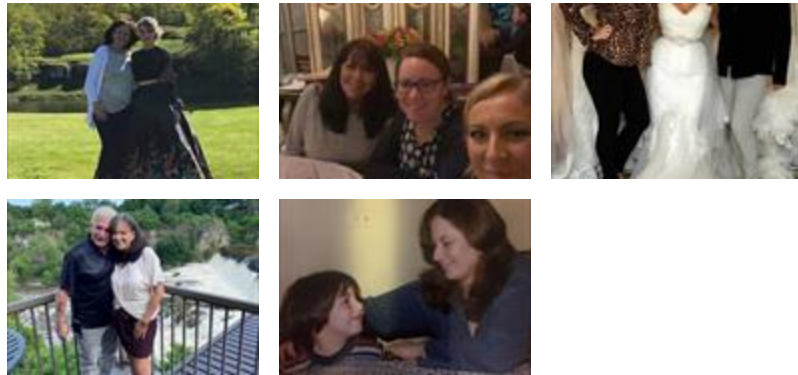

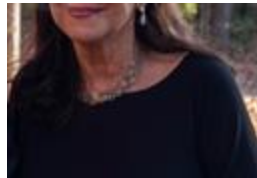
