Helga Valcic, age 88 years, of Cairo, New York, passed away on Thursday, August 1, 2024, after a brief illness, at The Pines Nursing Home and Rehabilitation Center, Catskill, New York, surrounded by her loving family. Helga was born on February 12, 1936, in Kade, Germany and is the daughter of the late Siegmund and Marie (Schroeter) Kamer.

In 1958 Helga immigrated from East Germany to The United States, she and her husband Milan married in The United States.

Helga relocated from Queens, N.Y. to South Cairo, N.Y. in 1974.

Besides her parents, Helga is predeceased by her brother Helmuth Kamer in 1945, her former husband Milan Valcic in 1995, and Oskar Kofler, her partner for 37 years in 2016.

During Helga's lifetime, she was employed as a Registered Nurse, receiving her bachelor's degree at Hunter College in Manhattan, N.Y. Helga was an O.R. Supervisor at Wyckoff Heights Hospital in Brooklyn, N.Y., and then was also an O.R. Supervisor at The Samuel S. Stratton V.A. Medical Center, Albany, N.Y. She was responsible for the staff in the operating room and encouraged many to future nursing careers according to their talents.

After her retirement, she wintered in Florida with Oskar.

Helga is survived by her two daughters Debbie Hotaling (David), their son Kyle Hotaling, and Maureen Rocco (Michael), their daughter Sierra, their son Tyler, his wife Morgan (Briar and Jonah) and her great grandson Koa Carson. She is also survived by two siblings Erika and Harald and several nieces and

nephews in Germany.
