



James F. Keefe Jr.

September 25, 1943 - September 24, 2019

On Tuesday, September 24, 2019, James Francis Keefe, Jr., successful attorney, devoted public servant, and loving partner, father, and grandfather, passed away at age 75.

James F. Keefe was born on September 25, 1943, in Sayre, PA, to James Francis Keefe, Sr., and Margaret Steele Keefe. He graduated from Owego Free Academy in 1961 and earned a bachelor's degree from Alfred University in 1965. He received his Juris Doctorate from Albany Law School and was admitted to the bar in 1968. He served in the Vietnam War from 1968 to 1970 where he held the rank of Captain and was assigned as a Provost Marshall in the U.S. Army's Military Police. He practiced law in Cairo for over 50 years, was the town attorney for 20 years, and served as the Town Supervisor for 13 years.

Jim was a staunch proponent of his town, Cairo. He was instrumental in creating the town's ambulance service and its water and sewer system, along with many other projects that enhanced his beloved community. He was known for his quick wit, wise counsel, and loyal friendship.

Jim was preceded in death by his brother, Philip. He is survived by Carole Miller, his partner of 25 years; his four children, Jennifer (Chris) McKee, Melissa (Matt) McGowan, James F. Keefe, III, and Megan Keefe (Andy Bone);

three grandchildren, Cassidy, Samantha, and Lucas; and sisters Margaret Keefe and Dorothy Miani.

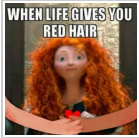

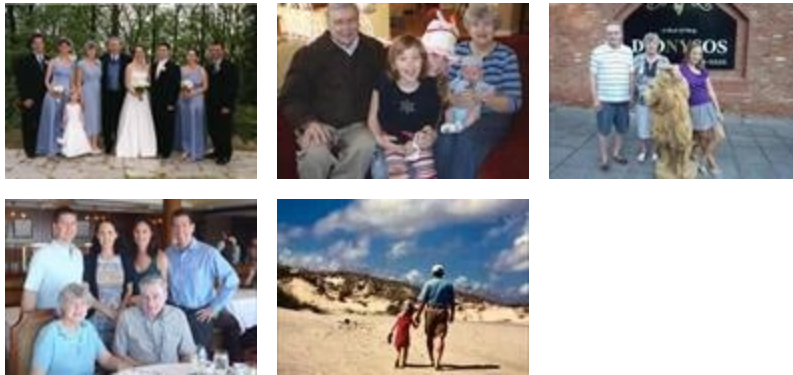
