



Mr. Joseph B. Iraci

Joseph B. Iraci, Ed.D., age 78, of Athens, passed away February 2, 2017. Joe was born in Buffalo, New York, and was the son of the late Samuel B. and Theresa Iraci.

He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Barbara Iraci of Athens, son Samuel J. (Kimberly) of Phelps, N.Y., daughter Laura (Jeffrey) of Mountain View, CA, daughter Bethany of Rochester N.Y., seven grandchildren, brother Samuel F. (Cecilia) Iraci of Alexandria Bay, N.Y., and several nieces, nephews and cousins.

Joe was an educator for over 30 years, moving from the classroom to the State Education Department, to Superintendent of Minisink Valley Central Schools in Orange County N.Y., and District Superintendent of Hamilton, Fulton, Montgomery BOCES. He also taught and developed curriculum at the College of St. Rose in Albany.

After retirement, he continued his public service as Supervisor of the Town of Athens and through memberships on various boards including Catholic Charities, D.R.Evarts Library, Senior Housing of Athens, Catskill Kiwanis and Coxsackie-Athens Rotary Clubs.

Participating in the Eagle Scouts throughout his life, Joe was particularly proud of his eldest grandson's induction this fall.

He had a life-long love of music and played many instruments, including piano and bass. Joe supported himself in his youth by playing in local quartets.
