June Inez Wilber Johannes, beloved wife, mother and friend, 80, of Acra, N.Y. passed peacefully after a battle with cancer on March 2, 2022, surrounded by her loved ones.

June was born August 22, 1941, daughter of Ralph Vincent Wilber and Inez Marshall Wilber in Poughkeepsie, N.Y.

June grew up in Netherwood, East Park and Salt Point and went to a one room schoolhouse in Netherwood. She graduated from Roosevelt High School in 1959.

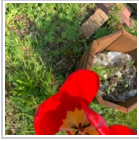
