Lois M. Rockefeller, age 85 years, of Durham, passed away on July 4, 2019, at Albany Medical Center, Albany, N.Y.

She was born on May 5, 1934, in Saugerties, N.Y. and is the daughter of the late Eugene and Magdalene (Wolven) Myers.

During her lifetime, Lois was employed as a clerk for The Building Department for the Town of Durham.
