Loretta Loughman (Emmerson), 98, passed away on January 3, 2019.

Loretta was born in New Rochelle, N.Y. on February 19, 1920, to Josephine and Walter Emmerson.

She married Edward Loughman in 1940 and moved to Cairo, N.Y. in 1973 from City Island, NY.

Loretta was always volunteering for a good cause. She was involved in both the Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts while raising her family as well as her parish church on City Island. She crocheted quilts for family, friends and residents of the FASNY Fireman's Home.

Loretta was a Lector and Eucharistic Minister in her parish church of Sacred Heart Cairo for 27 years.
