Margaret T. Rivenburg, age 95 years, passed away on June 18, 2021, at Ten Broeck Commons, Lake Katrine, N.Y.

She was born on February 9, 1926, in the Bronx, N.Y. and was the daughter of the late Andrew and Mary (Kroepfl) Koska.

The family moved to Middleburgh running a dairy farm and boarding house. After high school, Margaret was employed as an executive secretary at Commercial Decal on 5th Avenue in N.Y.C. On her return to Middleburgh, she was employed at Empire Insurance and also in true Rosie The Riveter tradition during WWII she worked at the Army Depot Fiscal Dept. in Schenectady, N.Y. In 1952 while out dancing she met her future husband, Linsen "Bucky" Rivenburg. They married in 1953 embarking on many entrepreneurial ventures while raising their five children. Margaret and Linsen's last venture was the South Cairo Bait and Tackle Shop from 1977 to Bucky's death in 1999.

In addition to her parents, and her husband Linsen in 1999, Margaret was predeceased by her sister, Mary Koska Keith; and her stepson Mickey Rivenburg.

Survivors include her stepdaughter, Dawn (Patrick) Gann; her son Andrew Rivenburg; her four daughters, Marlina (Hank) Eberle, Teresa Rose, Kathleen Robbins and Barbara (John) Klassen.
