Raymond E. Adams, age 94, of Cairo, NY and Fort Lauderdale, FL, passed away Tuesday, September 27, 2022 at Columbia Memorial Hospital, Hudson, NY, after a brief illness.

He was born July 20, 1928 in Purling NY, the son of the late John Adams and Magdalina (Lena) Muller.

Ray graduated from Cairo Central School, and then joined The U.S. Air Force where he served from February 1947 – February 1950. He went on to work at IBM in Kingston for 40 years.

An outdoorsman, Ray was a dedicated Little League coach, active in The Cairo Fish & Game Club, and enjoyed hunting, trapping and just being in the woods. He also was instrumental in starting the Conservative Party in Greene County. Since his retirement, Ray would spend the winter in Florida where he took great pleasure in working on many projects in the marine business with his son Mark. He was always willing to help someone if needed.

Ray was preceded in death by Alice, his wife of 62 years, his brother Stanley, his sister Emily, and half-brother John and half-sister Catherine.

He is survived by his son Mark (Lisa) of Crystal River, FL.
