Robert George Federico, 67, passed away suddenly on July 13, 2015 near his home in Virginia.

Bob was born in Catskill, New York, on November 4, 1947. He was the son of Joseph and Edith (Abby)Federico.

Bob grew up in Catskill attending Catskill High School graduating in 1965. He was able to attend his 50th class reunion in June reconnecting with many of his old classmates. Bob attended Hudson Valley Community college and then enlisted in The United States Army. He attended Officers Candidate School and then served in Vietnam form 1969-1970. He remained in The U.S. Army for nine years obtaining the rank of Captain. Bob continued with his education and obtained his masters degree in the state of Virginia. At the time of his death he was employed by the United Stated Federal Government.

He loved spending many hours with Robert his youngest child exploring new adventures. Being with his oldest daughter Elizabeth and granddaughter Cordelia brought him great joy. He was looking forward to retirement and having more time to be with family .He will always be remembered for his kindness.
