Robert. F Litchko Sr, 80, of Athens passed away peacefully at home on January 24, 2024 with his family by his side. Bob was an extremely hard working man who loved riding his Harley with his son and grandsons, and cruising in his 1948 Ford Coupe with his wife of 60 years Judith Litchko. Bob was a member of the West Athens Fire Department from 1979-1984. In his younger days he raced cars at Lebanon Valley Speedway.

Bob is predeceased by his brother George Litchko of Cocksackie and his daughter Tammy Barror of Florida.

He is survived by his wife Judith Litchko, his sons Brian Litchko of Athens and Robert Litchko Jr of Cairo as well as 6 grandsons, 2 great grandsons, and his first grand daughter who is due at the end of the month.

Bob was an amazing "Grampy" who never missed any of his grandson's basketball or baseball games. He was always there to cheer them on.
