Robert L. Story, age 87 years, of Acra, N.Y., passed away on December 28, 2021,

Bob was born on the family farm on February 8, 1934, in Freehold, N.Y., and is the son of the late Lester H. and Eva M. (Armstrong) Story.

Bob graduated Salutatorian from Cairo Central School. He also graduated from St. Lawrence University with a degree in business administration, followed by a career with the West Bend Corporation.

Bob was an avid hunter and angler. He was a member of The Greene County Federation of Sportsman, The Cairo Fish and Game Club where he helped with Youth Fishing Derbys, Youth Pheasant Hunts and fundraising efforts for conservation. 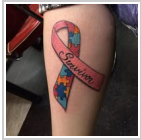
