Sara J. Bull (Johnson), passed away Wednesday morning March 11, at home surrounded by her family.

Her legacy began on the family's farm in Friendsville, PA, where she grew up with her two sisters (Betty and Nancy) and two brothers (Bud and Gary). She graduated from Vestal High School and then moved on to earn her Nursing Degree at the Albany Medical Center, School of Nursing.
