



Mr. Theodore J. Nugent

May 10, 1942 - October 25, 2017

Greenville— Theodore J. Nugent, 75, passed away suddenly on Wednesday, October 25, 2017 at St. Peters Hospital with his family at his side. He was born in Brooklyn on May 10, 1942, to the late Theodore and Helen (Krason) Nugent. After automotive trades school he was employed by Dictation Disk in Brooklyn. He met his bride of 55 years Bernadette Rose Scarpa in Brooklyn's Grand Prospect Hall. For years they vacationed in the old Chic-A -Dee campground in Cairo and in 1972 moved to Greenville and opened John's Pizzeria & Restaurant. Greenville was the new home to the Nugent family. The rest is history... Along with the restaurant they then purchased a concession trailer from Matt Chesbro (Matt Dogs) and "Johns Mobile" was born. Ted, Bernadette and family did many fairs and festivals and were known for their Sausage & Peppers. As soon as they moved to Greenville, Ted, Bernadette and family became communicants of St John the Baptist in Greenville. He joined the choir and was still a melodious voice until his death. Ted touched many lives. Ted joined the Greenville Fire Company in 1972. He served as Fire Police Captain and was a Life member. He was a member of the Greenville Rescue Squad. He drove school bus for Greenville Central, in 1990 he was elected as Councilman for the Town of Greenville where he served for 15 years and served 8 years as Deputy Supervisor. He was a catechist at St John's. In 1995 Ted and his family started Tri-County Enterprises which operated Richards Ambulette and Dove Limousine and Motorcoach. He loved driving Limousine and helping make a special day for new brides. Ted was also known for his customer service and personality as he and Bernadette ran Stone Willy's Pizza and Subs at Cumberland Farms Greenville. He loved talking with everyone as he served them coffee and breakfast sandwiches. He worked in advertising and sales for the Greenville Press and sold monuments and memorials for Cherry Valley Memorials. Most recently Ted has been involved helping his kids with the new family venture Scarpa's Catering. Which was named after someone he adored, Bernadette's father John(Mary) Scarpa.

Survivors include his wife, Bernadette Rose(Scarpa)Nugent; a son Theodore E.(Hope) Nugent; two daughters Kristine (Lou) Pastina and Kathryn(John)Dingman; six grandchildren, Victoria(Kevin) Crawley; Theodore E. Nugent Jr.; Amanda Gossman; Katelyn, Gianna and Louis Pastina; a brother Joseph (Linda) Nugent of Liberty; two great

grandchildren, Kevin Jr. and Reagan Crawley; sister-in-law, Adrienne (Warren) Franklin of Brooklyn; nieces and nephews, Brian Nugent, Sheryl Nugent, Warren(Diane)Franklin, Mary Franklin, Joseph(Felicia) Franklin; his childhood friend Butch(Carol) Atkinson of Ohio and many cousins, friends and extended families at St Johns, the Fire Company and Richards Funeral Home.

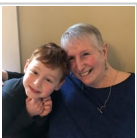
