Violet Helen (St. Eve) Obach, age 101 years, formerly of Florida, passed away on September 21, 2017, at the home of her daughter in Acra, New York.

Violet "Vi" Obach was born in Green Bay Wisconsin on January 21, 1916 to parents Emil and Eva (Koch) St. Eve.

The family moved to New York City and eventually to the Catskill Mountains where her parents and business partner George Bezolt opened a resort in Purling in 1935 which was named Eva's Farm. Vi enjoyed the guests and made sure they were happy; many returning for decades.

Violet and her younger sister Evelyn, ran the resort after their parents passed away. "Vi" loved to dance and could still do the polka at age 100. She was a staunch Roman Catholic and attended The Sacred Heart Church in Cairo and St. Helens Church in Lauderdale Lakes, Florida.

She married George "Bob" Obach on October 18, 1936. In the early 1980's they moved to Lauderdale Lakes in Florida. Her beloved husband died in 1994.

She is survived by three children; Elaine, Richard and Robert; 9 grandchildren 22 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren.

A Memorial Mass will be held at The Sacred Heart Church, Cairo, New York, on Saturday, October 7, 2017 at 11:00 A.M. with Rev. Fr. Michael Flannery, as The Celebrant.

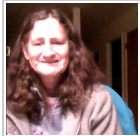
